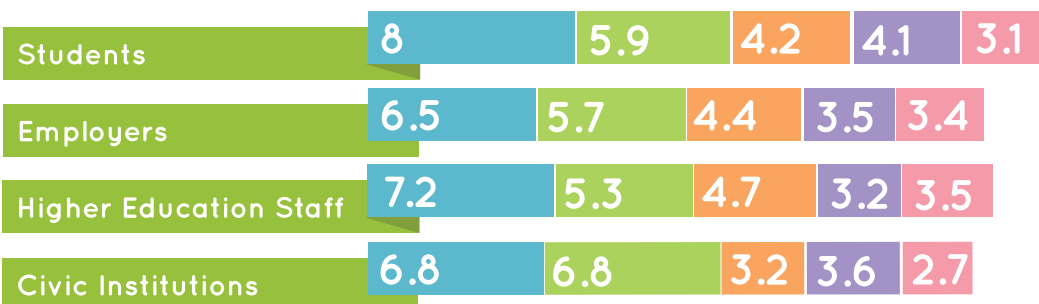


COMPETENCES CONSIDERED MOST IMPORTANT TO ALL STAKEHOLDERS

EMPLOYERS IDENTIFIED THE FOLLOWING AS KEY ISSUES FOR TRAINING DIGITAL SKILLS:

EDUCATIONAL EXPERTS IDENTIFIED THE FOLLOWING KEY ELEMENTS:

- Emphasis is needed on autonomy when learning and using digital tools
- Difficulty evaluating digital skills during the recruitment process
- Perception that HE does not educate digital skills with sufficient intensity

- Digital skills are not made explicit in job posting
- An imbalance in the teaching of the different competence areas
- Digital skills courses have no systematic curricular approach
- Situated learning or Problem Based Learning is suggested as best practice
